

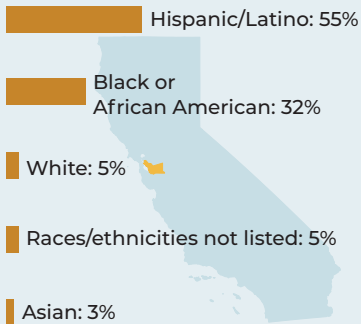

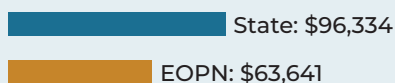

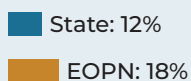
Community Composition

East Oakland Promise Neighborhood (EOPN) focuses on creating a thriving, joyful, and safe East Oakland where every student succeeds and every family belongs. Oakland Promise leads the EOPN initiative in partnership with Oakland Unified School District (OUSD) and a network of community-based organizations, all committed to building lasting support systems. Three of EOPN's four partner schools are Full-Service Community Schools. OUSD first implemented this model in 2011, and by 2023, all K-12 schools had community school managers, who are well positioned to support EOPN.



Early Childhood Education

42% of children aged 4 or younger have access to early learning spots.

EOPN will expand access to high-quality early learning including subsidized centers, home-based providers, and informal care networks.



K-12 Education

45% of students in EOPN schools were chronically absent in 2023-24.

EOPN will address root causes of absenteeism (e.g., transportation, safety, connection to school) previously identified through a needs assessment.



College and Career Readiness

45% of EOPN 2023 graduates enrolled in college within 6 months.

EOPN will support dual enrollment for Castlemont High School students through its partnership with Peralta Community College District.



Family and Community Supports

12% of students noted a friend or family member had died by violence.

Youth Alive!, an EOPN partner, will train high schoolers to deliver violence prevention workshops to middle school students.
