

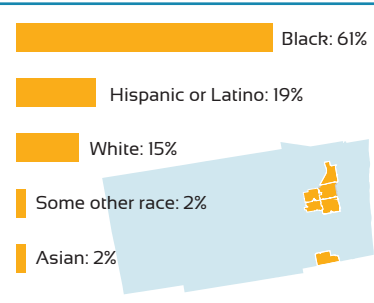

Broward College, Broward County Public Schools—the sixth-largest school district in the nation—and community and municipal partners began a movement in Broward County, Florida, to ensure everyone, no matter where they live or the color of their skin, has the opportunity to realize their *unlimited potential* (UP). Broward UP Promise Neighborhoods leverage a community-focused approach to promote postsecondary education in areas most affected by intergenerational poverty. They were launched by Broward College president Gregory Adam Haile and 19 other community leaders in September 2018.

### Innovative Strategy Spotlight

Broward UP's comprehensive two-generation (2-gen), community-centric model delivers key solutions along the cradle-to-career pipeline for children, families, and community members. One strategy that embodies this 2-gen approach is the Family Navigator program. The Family Navigator is the primary point of contact for families to interact with the Broward UP network. By addressing the needs of students and their families and connecting partners to better serve the whole family unit, the Family Navigator program inherently takes a 2-gen approach.
